¹ Testimony was not on Bill C-391 but on past audit of the program. The Auditor General said: "We found that the government had made satisfactory progress in recording and reporting the full costs of the program. At that time, we noted that the annual expenditures for the centre had decreased from \$117.3 million, in the 2002-03 fiscal year, to \$71 million, in 2004-05. We also noted improvements in the handling of the large volumes of applications, as well as in reporting to Parliament... we found [the RCMP] had made good progress in assessing the costs"
